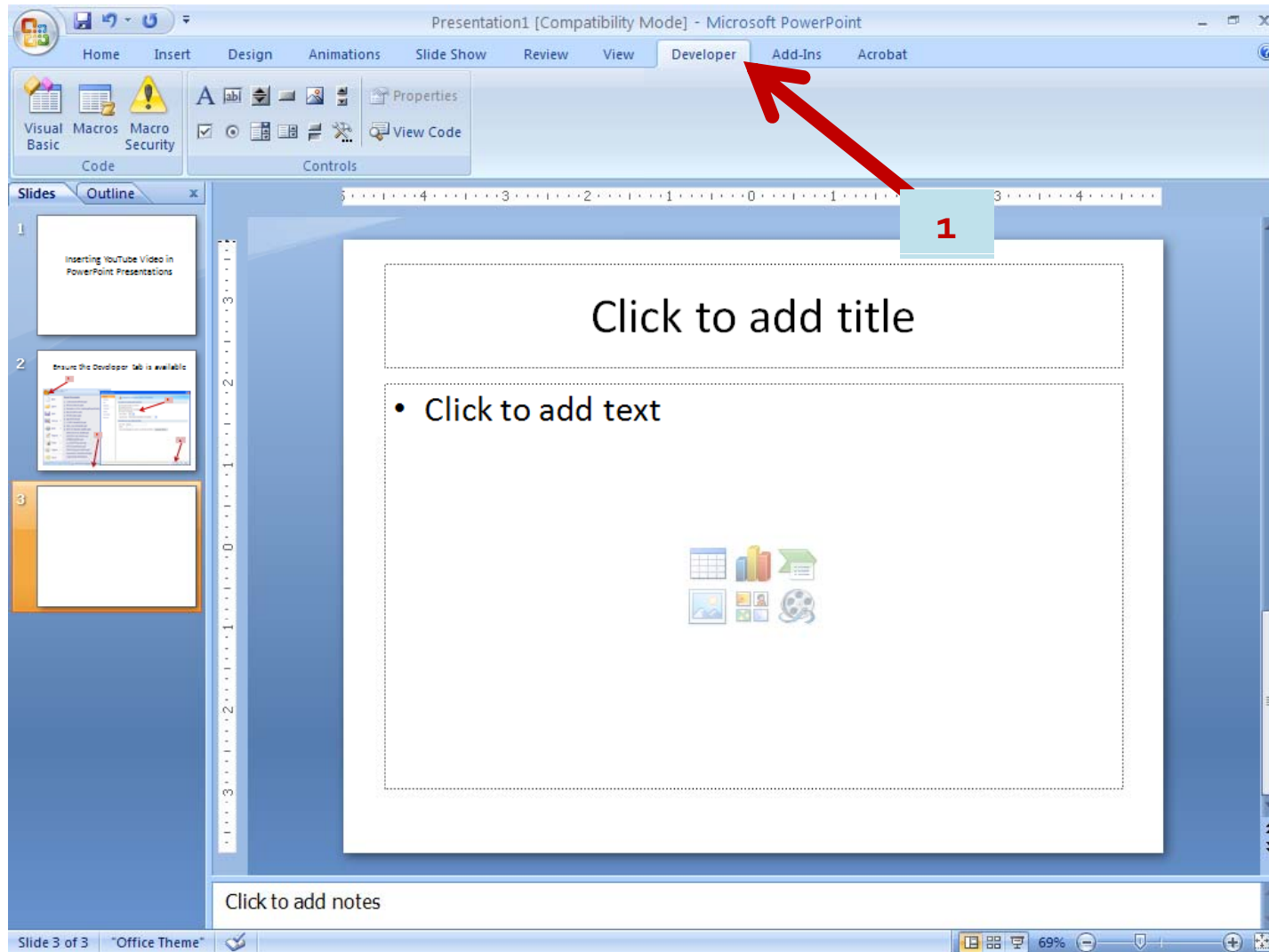

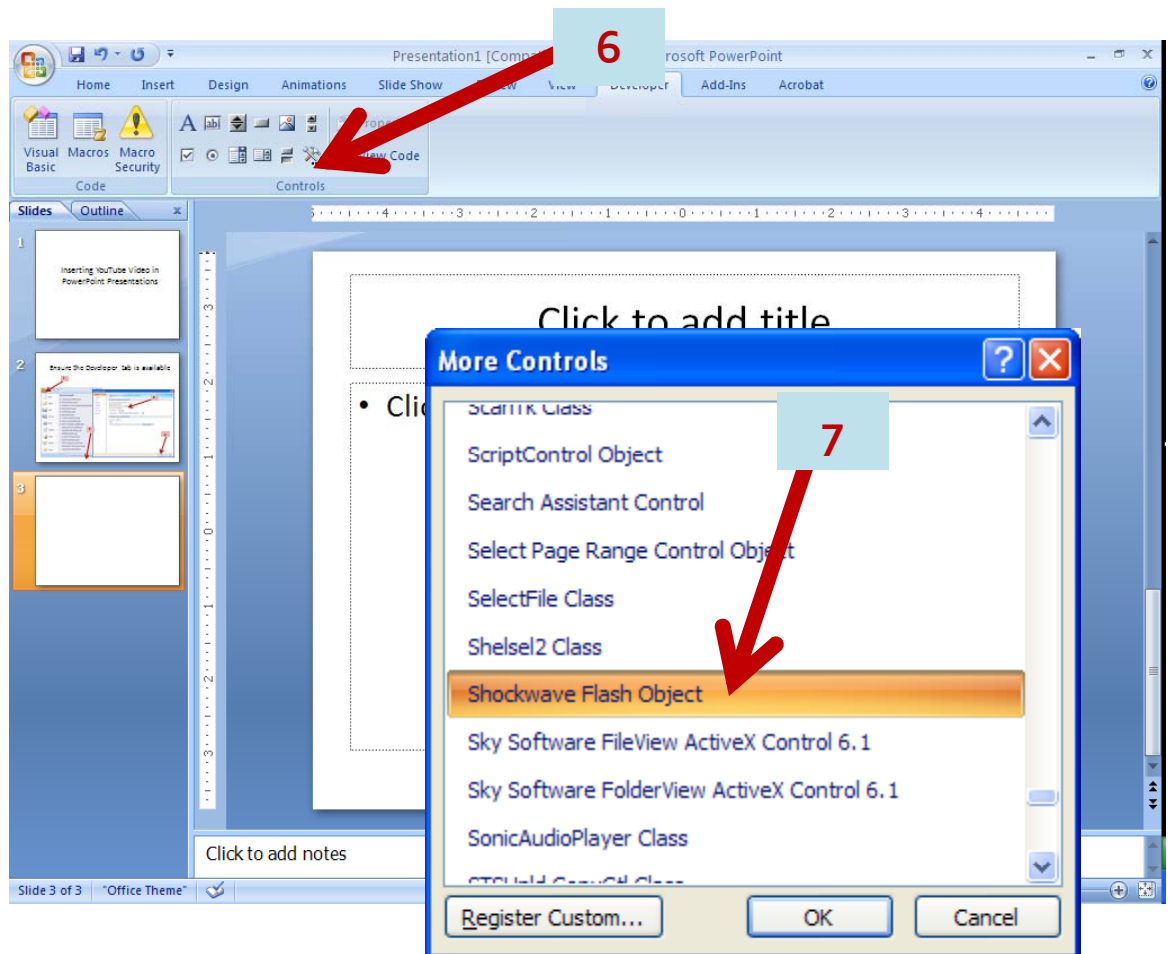
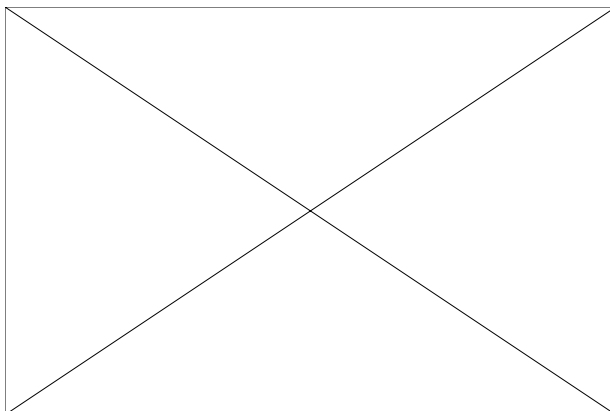

Inserting the Video

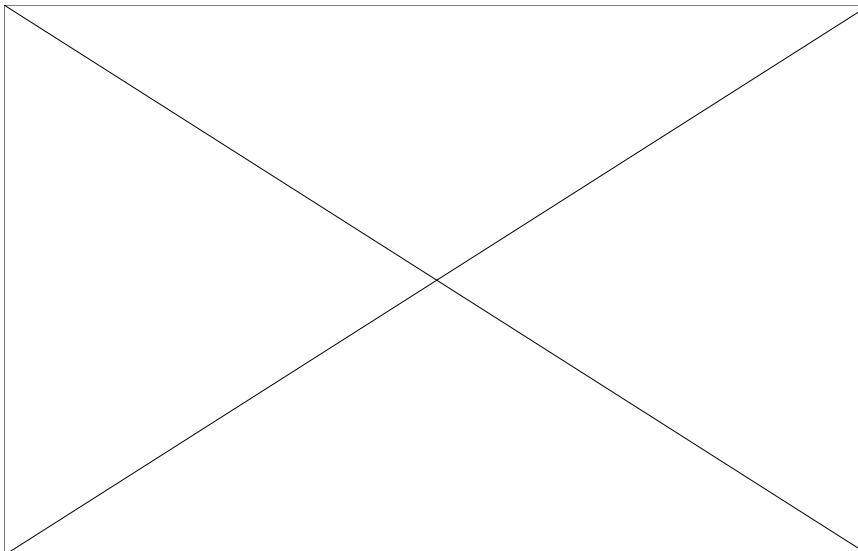
- Click on Toolbox
- Scroll to find Shockwave Flash Object
- Draw box where you want your video (can be resized)

- Go to your YouTube video
- Copy the URL (control + C)
- Back to your presentation draw box, right click
- Click on Properties
- Go to Movie and paste the URL (control + v)
- Delete "watch?"
- Replace "=" with "/"

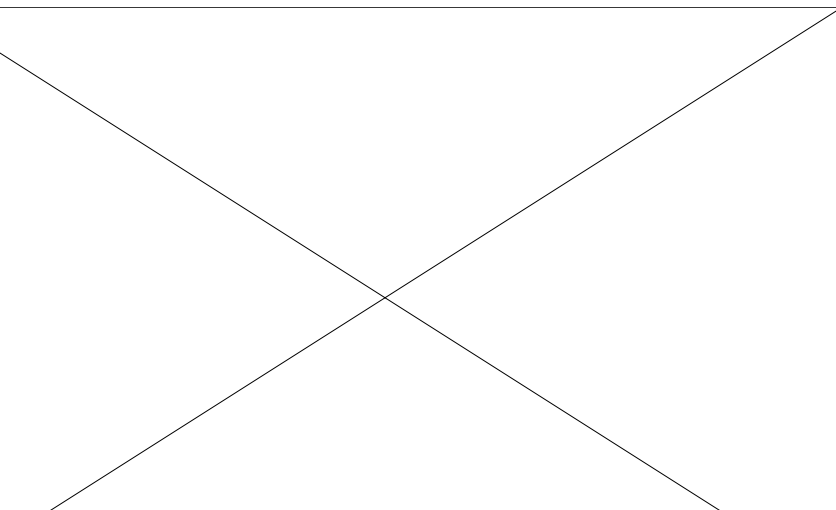
